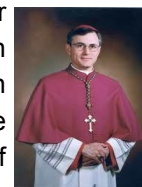
A GOSPEL CELEBRATION WITH ELVIS PRESLEY:

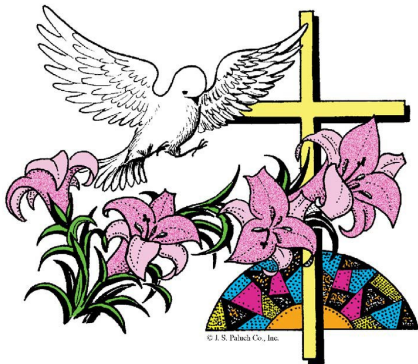

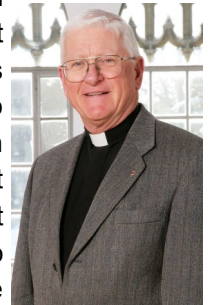
