**SACRAMENTAL PREP TEAM NEEDS YOUR HELP:** The Sacramental Preparation Team (SPT) at St. Justin's Parish is a small group of volunteer parishioners who are catechized, love children and are passionate about sharing their faith with them. Under the guidance of the Holy Spirit and under the direction of our Pastoral Minister, Suzanne Walton and our parish priests, Father Mark Poulin and Father Mark Maloney, we create and implement parish formation programs for the sacraments of Baptism, First Reconciliation, Eucharist and Confirmation. Over the past three years we have assisted in expanding our Parish's sacramental preparation programs. This has been achieved only by the grace of God and the guidance of the Holy Spirit. We have planted many seeds and pray that these will bear abundant fruit in the spiritual growth of our families.

**School Based Programs:** Our programs are expanding in September 2017. One of our goals with these new programs is to build stronger parish/school ties. We will be piloting a program in Sir Arthur Carty School and will require two volunteers who will visit the grade 7 and 8 classes once a month for approximately 30 to 40 minutes throughout the school year to assist the teachers in preparing the children for their sacraments. **Baptism Preparation:** We are also needing two additional volunteers to assist with baptism preparation. If you enjoy working with young families in guiding them to a spiritual and active faith life, this ministry is for you. Sessions are held throughout the year as needed.
