C.W.L. GENERAL MEETING: The next general meeting is on Wednesday, March 6th following the Ash Wednesday Mass. Hope to see you there.

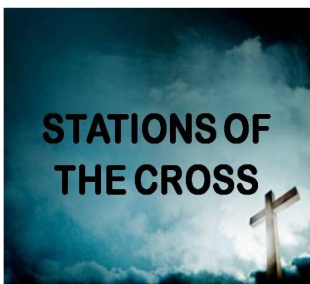

RCIA THE RITE OF ELECTION FOR THE UNBAPTIZED: March 10 at St. Peter's Cathedral at 3 PM. The celebration of the Rite of Election, which coincides with the opening of Lent, marks the beginning of the final, more intense period of preparation for the sacraments of initiation during which the elect are encouraged to follow Christ with great generosity. At this second step, based on the testimony of godparents and catechists and the catechumen's reaffirmation of their intention, the Church judges their state or readiness and decides on their advancement toward the sacraments of initiation. Thus, the Church makes its election that is, the choice and admission of those catechumens who have the dispositions that make them fit to take part in the sacraments of initiation. This step is called election because the acceptance made by the Church is founded on the election by God, in whose name the Church acts. The step, also called the enrollment of names because as a pledge of fidelity the candidates inscribe their names in the book that lists those chosen for initiation.

RCIA THE RITE OF CALLING FOR THE BAPTIZED: March 10 at St. Justin's at 11 AM. The Rite of Calling Candidates to Lenten Renewal acknowledges the seriousness with which baptized but uncatechised adults begin the Lenten season. With the entire faith community, they are invited to use this holy season in preparation for the renewal of their baptismal promises at Easter. In a special way, they will prepare to become full members of the Church during the Easter season.

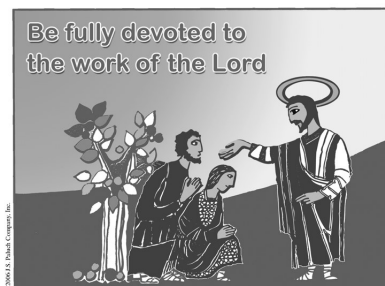
